

Lounge Area Rules

- We I.D. EVERYONE for the purchase of adult beverages.
- All food, chewing gum and/or drink must stay in the concession stand eating area and other designated areas on the lower levels as marked. Only bottled water may be taken into the playing arenas.
- All food and drink must be purchased from the concession stand. Special occasion cakes and treats for birthdays, team parties, or graduations, etc. are the exception unless previously arranged through a rental contract. All items are to be served in the designated area.
- All adult beverages must be consumed in the lounge area unless previously arranged in a rental contract.
- Tables are for eating, chairs are for sitting – please use them respectfully.
- Please dispose of your trash in the proper receptacles. Help us to keep the lounge area beautiful.
- No changing of uniforms/clothing is permitted in the lounge. Team gear should be stored in a safe manner. Please use our locker facilities.
- No private coolers are permitted.
- A picnic shelter is provided outside the fence for those who bring their own lunch or snacks.
- Patrons are not allowed behind the concession stand or adjoining storage area.
- No smoking or use of any tobacco products is allowed.
- No one is allowed to enter under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- No glass containers are allowed.
- No foul language or verbal abuse is allowed.
- Radios, horns and other noise making devices are not permitted in the lounge area unless a special event is in progress.
- No animals are allowed.
- Sports Network and Fitness, Inc. is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- No loitering or “horseplay” is permitted in the lounge.
- Petting or necking is not permitted. Grabbing, groping, interlocking or hanging on among patrons must be restricted; patrons are required to “keep their distance” from each other. Young children with an adult (such as an older family member) are an exception.
- Failure to follow rules can result in serious injury or damage and may result in a patron being required to leave the facility.
